Pinnacles Peak

DISTANCE: 4 miles ELEVATION GAIN: 1000 feet ROUTE TYPE: Out & Back

The Pinnacles Peak Hiking Trail: Unlike the <u>Heaps Peak Arboretum Trail</u> or <u>North Shore Trail</u>, The Pinnacles peak is both lightly trafficked and not surrounded by trees. Located in a high section of the mountain, The Pinnacles Peak resembles a <u>Joshua Tree hike</u>. The landscape is covered with sand and various boulders, which are popular with mountain climbers.

The Pinnacles Peak trail is an up & back 4.5-5 mile hike that features hundreds of boulders along the trail. The trailhead starts near the Arrowhead Fish & Game Shooting range. Don't let the sound of pistols startle you, as the trail does not cross in near of the range area. The trail continues up to the boulders summit area and is marked.

A day parking permit is required for the parking area. Permits can be <u>purchased online</u>.

Estimated Time: 2 hours

Total Distance: 4.5 miles (round-trip)
