Of the hundreds of hikes I have done, this one is one of my all time favorites. Happened to time it perfectly to catch the super bloom of wildflowers. There are some in the first 2 miles, but the bulk of the wildflowers are between 2 and 4 miles. It's not a hard hike at all. I mapped it to 10.6 miles. Trail is well established and clearly marked. Love this hike. Go soon to catch the wildflowers before it gets hot
