

Texas / El Paso - Hueco Tanks

Chain Trail

DISTANCE: 2 miles

ELEVATION GAIN: 200 feet

ROUTE TYPE: vary

The trail is hard to follow once you get past the chains. It was fun to see all the climber hand holds and the view was nice looking down the south side of north mountain. Once was good enough for me, probably wouldn't hike again.

Called the "chain trail" because the steeper sections have posts and chains to help preserve balance. It goes about 3/4 up the mountain. I saw a half-dozen climbers up there enjoying the bouldering (?). There are "trails" up there but they are not marked very well. When I couldn't tell I stayed on rocks as much as possible.

Very nice trail, walking on the rocks and enjoy the beautiful views from the top. This a very nice place to visit with the family, kids will enjoy a lot especially just after the rainy season, you will find water on the rocks, beautiful plants and flowers.
