

Washington / Grand Coulee

Steamboat Rock Trail

DISTANCE: 4 miles

ELEVATION GAIN: 900 feet

ROUTE TYPE: Loop

Pay close attention to the surrounding area when you hike from the parking lot to the Mountain, there are plenty of deer that like to hang out under the few trees that offer shade. Also note that this hike is like walking on the beach. The first section of the trail is mostly sand.

Once reaching the "climb" area, also pay close attention, although it looks like only one trail up, there is a trail almost directly next to the "most traveled" that offers a much easier access. Once you reach the top, you have the option to take the trail to the left or the right. There are quite a few trails to follow depending on what area you want to see, if you want to do a longer hike, you can make a day of it.

Remember you are in rattlesnake country!
